All outcomes and data obtained were collected through parents and doctors. The intention is to make this valuable information available via the **online prediction tool**. Using this tool, parents can search for information about, for example, the medical problems that you are most likely to encounter. This is also a guideline for doctors on how to treat these children and what to look out for. The latter is very important because children with abnormalities on the 6th chromosome do not walk according to medical guidelines.

The researchers working on the UMCG's 'Chromosome 6 Project' practically all do this on a voluntary basis, but money is needed to get the prediction tool online!
